

**NOTICE TO APPLICANTS**

**This notice contains important rules and regulations for the day of the Math Entrance Examination. Please read it carefully.**

**RULES AND REGULATIONS**

- **YOU MUST** bring your Exam Identification Document (EID) and original passport to the exam
- **YOU MUST** only have on your desk what you need to complete the exam. Ensure you have black or blue pens)
- **YOU MUST** leave outside of University premises any mobile phones, smart watches, calculators or other electronic devices (digital sound recorders, MP3 players, cameras, etc.).
- **YOU MUST** stop writing immediately when told to do so.
- **YOU MUST** wait until the invigilator has collected your exam materials before you leave your seat.

- **DO NOT** open your question paper until instructed to by the invigilator.
- **DO NOT** cheat, copy, or give anything to, take anything from, or talk to another candidate.
- **DO NOT** talk to, signal to or disturb other candidates during the exam.
- **DO NOT** attempt to use any support materials not specifically approved for your exam.
- **DO NOT** use erasable pens, correction fluid or tape on any exam materials.
- **DO NOT** smoke, eat or drink in the exam room, apart from water in a clear plastic bottle.
- **DO NOT** leave the exam room for any reason without the permission of the invigilator.
- **DO NOT** take any question papers or answer sheets out of the exam room.

**ADVICE AND INFORMATION**

**Make sure you are on time**

- Arrive well before the scheduled start time. Entrance will be open at 2 pm. Exam starts at 3 pm.
- If you arrive late after 3 pm, you will not be allowed to take the exam.

**Advice and assistance during the test**

- Listen to the invigilator and follow the instructions.
- If you are not sure about what to do, raise your hand to attract attention. The invigilator will come to your assistance.
- You must not ask for, and will not be given, any explanation of the questions.
- Read carefully and follow the instructions on the question paper and answer sheet.

**Tell the invigilator at once if:**

- you are left handed or ambidextrous with left hand preference
- your personal details on the Exam Identification Document are wrong
- the question paper is incomplete or badly printed
